She paid for what is like a meal at the fireside lounge and then is seen on video buying liquor at a store, which is enroute to a pre party being held at [REDACTED] met her there and she was already quite drunk. They went together to the Dal Year End Party and then [REDACTED] called her a cab and put her in it at around 2350 hours. The cab driver recalls the fare "Holly" and took her to Convoy Apartments. The cab driver recalls she was intoxicated and she had been fumbling through her purse. She slid across the seat behind the driver, paid the fare and got out of the cab on the drivers side and walked away from the building. The cab driver didn't notice she was blind. Items from her purse were located in the lot in parking area [REDACTED] her purse was with her when she was found. the only thing outstanding is her cane. The family advises she is totally blind but may see outlines in daylight and can sense light on in a room.

Writer spoke to Jim "JJ" Wasson of ident. he checked her purse and there was no cane. He noted she had abrasions on her hands and legs that looked like rubbing against concrete or a rough hard surface. She also had an abrasion on her abdomen area. Ident seized the clothing and nail clippings.

Writer attended Emerg and spoke to the family. The mother states had she been attacked she would have fought. She is a very independent woman. At the time of the visit her condition was improving, her core temp up to 32 degrees and the doctors were taking her off life support around 2000 hours.

At this time most task are complete. It is possible the victim got disorientated after getting out of the cab and somehow made her way to the fenced compound. She like fell and crawled a few times and its possible she either fell over a low spot of the fence that borders a foot path, or somehow made her way through an opening. Once inside had she felt the concrete posts, she may have mistake the ramp to the to as a path up and fell from the top of the concrete base. Had she somehow made it on the bridge and jumped she definitely would not have lived.

A few tasks remain to be completed but can be followed up next week. A grate in the parking lot is going to be removed and the drain searched for her cane in the event it fell in there. A few follow up interview can be completed the beginning of the week as well.
