reviewed the survey and believe the following statement applies:

HRM's asset management policies require a complete overhaul. My central priority is to ensure taxpayers receive value from their taxes. Without sound fiscal management, HRM cannot allocate funding to critical issues. We must balance the books without burdening citizens further.

Climate change and greenspaces are key in planning and improving the quality of life. By integrating both, we can reduce long-term costs and enhance the well-being of all Haligonians. The recent updates to the Housing Accelerator Fund (HAF) need to include climate action and consider the impact on neighborhoods' social and cultural fabric. I organized the first Town Hall on HAF in the South End, advocating for heritage districts in zoning adjustments and affordable housing.

Halifax, as a growing city, needs to improve its transit system by implementing rapid transit and giving priority to secondary bus routes over routes that lead to the waterfront.

The city's rapid growth has led to neglect of its past. I aim to honour the past to shape the future.
